Submission Procedure in Journal of Tikrit University for Agriculture Science

Manuscript Preparation: The following format must be used when submitting three single-sided copies of the manuscript for publication: Print the manuscript on a good quality A4 size white paper. Double-lines between lines at a submitting and single line format for the final copy. Leave a 2.5 cm on a top side of paper and 2-cm as margin on other sides. Use a single-column format and a standard font (e.g. 12 Times New Roman). Author names, and affiliations must appear on the first page of the manuscript. The manuscript should normally be arranged in the following order:

Title: The title of the manuscript should be descriptive and concise. It should be typed in Uppercase letters. It should be followed by the full names of all authors in both upper and lower-case letters. The affiliations, mailing and E-mail addresses of the author must be included.

Abstract: The abstract must be a single paragraph of 250 words or less. It should contain an concise summery of the manuscript including the primary objective of the research along with the major findings. Each paper should include English and Arabic abstracts.

Sections of The Manuscript: Submitted manuscript should include the following major headings: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion. The sections that correspond to the above headers should be in the presented order. Major heading should be centered and in upper-case letters. Some variation from this basic format is acceptable. For example, the results and discussion sections not be separated in two sections. The heading for review article should be asked on the topic of the paper.

Tables: Tables must be single-spacing, less than 17 cm width. All tables should be numbers consecutively, given concise titles, and cited in the text. Table should be included at a correct site of the paper along with illustrations.

References: There must be a reference for each text citation and vice versa. Your reference should provide the reader with the needed information to retrieve and examine the cited reference. The following guide lines are used for references:

- Arrange the list of cited references in alphabetical order by authors.
- Use initials for first and middle names in all citations.
- Initials are placed after the first author's last name but before the last name of all co-authors.
- Place the single-authored articles before those in which the individual is a senior author.
- List two or more titles chronologically when the authors of these references are identical.
- Use the letters a, b, etc. to indicate two or more titles by the same authors in the same year. For example, 1994a , 1994b, etc.

Example:

For periodicals:

Al-Tahamah, A.N., M.A. Moslem and K.A. Elkhder (2000). Chemical control of post-harvest disease of some fruits. Pak. J. Biol. Sci., 3: 599-601.

For edited symposia, special issues, etc. published in periodical:

Roberts, R.J. (1993). Ulcerative dermal necrosis (UDN) in wild salmonids. In: Bruno, D.W. (Ed.), Pathological conditions of wild salmonids. Fish Res., 17: 3 14.

For books:

Guagh, Jr., H.G. (1992). Statistical Analysis of Regional Yield Trails. Elsevier, Amsterdam.

For multi-authors books:

Bucke, D. (1989). Histology. In: Austin, B., Austin, D.A. (Eds.), Methods for the Microbiological Examination of Fish and Shellfish. Willy, New York, pp: 69-97.

Proofs: One set of galley proofs will be provided to the corresponding author for typographical checking only. Major inclusion will not be accepted at this stage. It should be returned within 72 hours of receipt.

Reprints: Authors will be provided with three reprints per paper free of charge.

The Publishing Fee: 100\$ a paper first 15 pages, and 5\$ for each other page.
