يستخدم المستقبل المستمر لوصف حدث او فعل مستقبلي سيكون مستمرا او متواصلا في وقت محدد في المستقبل.

1. Affirmative:

*S. (he, she, it, they, we, you, I) + Will + be + V. (ing) + Com. + \cdot

Ex: She will be learning a lot of new skills.

Ex: They will be working at the new company next month.

Ex: I will read a book tomorrow evening (Change into Future Continuous).

- I will be reading a book tomorrow evening.

2. Question:

Ex: Will they be watching a movie at the cinema on Saturday?

Ex: Will she be cooking dinner for us tonight?

Ex: We will travel to New York next month (Question).

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- Will we be travelling to New York next month?		
3. Negative:		
*S. + Will not/ won't + be + V. ing + com. + .		
Ex: Susan will not be attending the conference on Monday.		
Ex: This time next week, we will not be living in our new home.		
Ex: Ameer will not be shopping at the market tomorrow.		
Ex: Jessica will spend the summer on the coast (Negative).		
-Jessica won't be spending the summer on the coast.
